

Making flowers

Age 6+ (with some adult supervision)

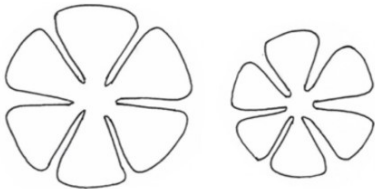
You will need

Coloured paper or felt
Buttons
Scissors
Sheet of A4 thick paper or card
Sticky tape
PVA glue

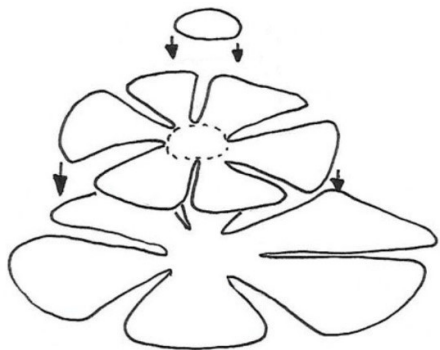


What to do

1. Lay out your paper or felt and cut out a selection of flower shapes in different sizes. Cut five small shapes and five big shapes. You can make them as simple or as fancy as you like!



2. Lay out all of the big flower shapes, and add a small dot of glue in the middle of each of them.
3. Next, sit a small flower shape on top of each of the big ones so that the glue sticks them both together.
4. Now, place a small dot of glue in the middle of each of the small flower shapes, and place a button on it.



5. Leave them to dry for 15 minutes.
6. Finally, use some sticky tape to attach each flower to a paper straw. Put them in a glass or vase – and enjoy your paper flowers!

Directions for Making Flowers

1. Cut out various sizes and shapes of flowers
2. Hole punch the center of the flower
3. Using a stick, straw, pipe cleaner stack multiple layers of flowers together
4. Add beads and leaves for extra flair
5. Deliver a bouquet to someone special. :)
